I am delighted to say that our Multi Use Games Area is finished and the children are using it! Each year group has one allocated lunchtime slot and we have chosen to give Year 6 an extra slot as they are in their final two terms at Burpham.

Educational Acronyms of the month!

In schools there are so many acronyms – have you come across these starting with A?

ADHD – Attention Deficit and Hyperactivity Disorder = neurobiological condition marked by persistent inattention, hyperactivity and sometimes impulsivity. Did you know 3.62% of 5 – 15 boys and 0.85% of girls have ADHD? Famous people with ADHD include comedian Rory Bremner, singer Justin Timberlake, Musician Will.i.am and Olympic swimmer Michael Phelps. ASD – Autism Spectrum Disorder = is the name for a range of similar life -long conditions, including Asperger syndrome, that affect a person's social interaction, communication, interests and behaviour. Approximately 1 person in every 100 is autistic with more boys than girls diagnosed. Famous people with ASD include singer Susan Boyle, naturalist Chris Packham, actor Dan Aykroyd and "I'm A Celebrity" contestant Anne Hegerty.
