Packed Lunches for School Trips

Our school caterer Pabulum will now be providing packed lunches for all school trips for all those children who usually have school meals. A standard packed lunch of a cheese sandwich (on brown bread), an apple, a bottle of water and a piece of homemade cake will be provided for every child who is having school meals. We will issue a packed lunch order form with school trip letters allowing parents to choose a different filling, white or brown bread and a choice of fruit (a bottle of water and a piece of homemade cake will always be provided). We will not chase parents for a packed lunch order form therefore if we do not receive one then we will assume that parents are happy with the standard packed lunch described above. Children who usually have packed lunches at school will be expected to bring in their own lunch as usual for school trips.

Penalty Notices

Just to remind parents/carers that if they take their child out of school without authorisation for 5 or more days, they will be liable to receive penalty notices. Currently, the amount payable under a penalty notice is £60.00 payable within 21 days, rising to £120.00 if paid within 21- 28 days. If the penalty notice is not paid within 28 days, the Local Authority will consider a prosecution in the Magistrates Court. Please note that Penalty Notices are issued per parent/carer per child, so a family with 2 parents/carers and 2 children will receive 4 penalty notices.

"I liked the counting of the superhero jewels to see who had more" Darcie
















From the Office
