Al About Pandora



Pandora is full of beautiful and deadly creatures of all shapes and sizes some of these animals can spend hours across the sky but you will find some hiding quietly in Pandora. One of the most fascinating creatures is the glass diaphores (a kind of sea anemone). The diaphores drinks poison from flowers and some eat leaves (the diaphores). The glass diaphores live in the jungle in Pandora. The sea anemone creatures help the sea in battle when the sea need to use their cross bow they can use one of the diaphores to keep their balance. The blue animals (the diaphores) have thin antennae that emerge either side of the top of the skull, which is really hard. A diaphores is not a normal sea anemone like a normal sea anemone. The Xenobiologists believe that the touch of antennae is for pleasure and aggression, but also means of transferring information about food sources and potential danger. Herds often move in unison slowly after touching antennae to bond with or to break. A diaphores's skin must touch the animal and connect their neural system to the animal's antennae for neural whip. The animal diaphores have gustatory tips that move constantly almost like a kind of sea green.
